

GUIDELINES FOR PATIENTS COMING FROM OTHER CITIES AND COUNTRIES



1. After your first contact with us, we will return, prompting you to fill out a form with questions that enable us to evaluate your case, needs and expectations more thoroughly.

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3. Sending the examination scores via e-mail allows its prior assessment. Hence, if necessary, we can prescribe you medication or other conduct and then repeat some examination. This allows us to gain time, thus optimizing your stay time in Rio de Janeiro.



2. We will align a videoconference aiming to enable a pre-evaluation. Dr. Gobbo will answer your questions and advise you on demanded pre-op examinations so that you can carry them out in your place of residence.



4. In order to avoid the thrombosis risk, if your flight to Rio de Janeiro has a duration of 4 hours or more, plan to arrive at least 48 hours before the scheduled surgical procedure.



5. It is essential to carry out a personal consultation before surgery. It may take place in the interim between your arrival in Brazil and your surgery date.



6. Most countries have an agreement with Brazil, exempting tourists from a mandatory visa. We advise you although to check out with the Brazilian consulate in your country the specific conditions applying to your case.



7. If you need, we can quote with providers a full service package tailored for your demand, incl.:

- Accommodation, incl. cleaning and laundry service;
- Catering /cook;
- Transportation;
- Interpreter etc.



10. A skilled post-op care team can be engaged to accompany you throughout this process:

- Nurse;
- Physiotherapist (for lymphatic drainage and other post-op physiotherapeutic techniques).



9. The duration of the recovery period is specific for each procedure. Following medical guidance and respecting deadlines and mobility limitations is paramount for your surgery's optimal final result.

- Materials such as girdles, bras, special bandages, medications, etc.;
- And everything else required to support your recovery.
